Terms and conditions: Cancer Therapy Pathways program rewards

On Nov. 1, 2019, we introduced our Cancer Therapy Pathways program to help promote the use of evidence-based and cost-effective regimens. In January 2020, we began offering the opportunity to earn rewards for meeting certain program requirements.

The following are the program terms and conditions:

- Care providers must be in-network for eligible UnitedHealthcare commercial plans in order to participate in the program
- Excludes UnitedHealthcare commercial plans identified as Indemnity/ Options PPO
- Eligibility for the rewards program varies by health plan and is subject to all applicable laws and regulations
- In order to qualify for the rewards program, the practicing provider must have at least 5 approved prior authorizations where a Cancer Therapy Pathway was offered
- Selecting a Cancer Therapy Pathway regimen doesn't guarantee eligibility or that rewards are earned
- Care providers in the following states and U.S. territories are not eligible for rewards: Hawaii, North Carolina, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands
- Contract amendment is required to receive program rewards in California,
 Delaware, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island,
 Virginia, Washington and West Virginia
- Rewards are made at a practice tax identification number (TIN) level
- Rewards won't be available for members who are covered by self-funded benefit plans sponsored by payers who are not participating in the program
- · If UnitedHealthcare suspects any fraud or abuse, we reserve the right to discontinue rewards
- UnitedHealthcare reserves the right to change, cancel, modify or temporarily suspend the program and its features, including reward eligibility, at any time without prior notice
