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CPSE: CPR0013230 Providers were submitting codes 0053, 84443, 85025, 85004, 85027, 85007, 85009 separately under case 03657512. We asked them to bundle the codes under 80050. However, because 80050 is a noncovered code for Ohio Medicaid, it was being denied. We're removing the V8N denial so the codes can be paid separately. The number of billing providers impacted is 6,252. The number of claims affected is 6,253.
