Overview

Behavioral health homes provide comprehensive behavioral health services to patients. As a primary care provider (PCP), this information can help you coordinate care for your patients, including where to find care and what kind is provided.

What is a behavioral health home?

A behavioral health home is an individual health care professional or a team of health care professionals who provide care to a patient, or coordinate and monitor the care of a patient. Treatment can include care for the primary, physical health and behavioral health needs to support the whole person. A health home can be a behavioral health outpatient clinic, a Federally Qualified Health Center or an integrated care provider. Patients may or may not be formally assigned to a health home.
