Indiana Medicaid: Updated billing requirements

Effective April 1, 2024

Effective April 1, 2024, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan is making the following changes to billing requirements for Indiana Medicaid, including Indiana Hoosier Care Connect. These changes apply to both professional and facility claims:

- · A billing taxonomy code must be included on all claims
- Provider demographic information listed on claims must match the Indiana Medicaid provider enrollment file
 - The data used to make a one-to-one match is the National Provider Identifier (NPI) number, ZIP+4 Code and the billing taxonomy

We will deny claims that don't include the billing taxonomy code and/or where the provider demographic information doesn't match the information in the Indiana Medicaid provider enrollment file.

To avoid claim denials, please ensure you are following the **guidance** provided by the Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP).
