

Comprehensive Dental Care for Adults with Developmental or Intellectual Disabilities Residing in an Intermediate Care Facility

Act 366 of the 2022 Regular Session will be effective May 1,2023. The Act provides for the coverage of comprehensive dental care for adults 21 years of age and older with developmental or intellectual disabilities who reside in an intermediate care facility (ICF).

Some diagnostic services, such as exams and some radiographic images, will be provided by the ICF. Providers should bill D0120, D0150, D0210, D0240, D0272 and D0330 to the ICF.

The following services should be billed to the beneficiary's assigned Dental Benefit Plan Manager (DBPM):

- Diagnostic services (excluding the codes listed above)
- Preventive services
- Restorative services
- Endodontics
- Periodontics
- Prosthodontics
- Oral and maxillofacial surgery
- Orthodontics
- Emergency care
