

# New ECHO Programs Are Starting

ECHO (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes) is an educational program that helps care providers learn more about specific conditions. Using videoconferencing technology, specialists share their expertise with area care providers. Biweekly meetings with an interdisciplinary team help care providers gain a deeper understanding of the treatments and options available to their patients.

Current ECHO programs address asthma, autism, child psych, chronic pain management, dermatology, healthcare ethics, Hepatitis C, opioid use disorder and HIV. New ECHO programs are starting soon to address high-risk obstetrics, Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome and other conditions.

As strong advocates of the ECHO programs, we encourage you to sign up for these collaborative programs led by your colleagues. There's no cost to participate and free Continuing Medical Education (CME) is available.
