



**Important Information for Pharmacies:
 UnitedHealthcare Community Plan
 Vaccine and Immunization/Injection Network Participation
 Effective Aug. 1, 2019**

UnitedHealthcare’s pharmacy benefits administrator, OptumRx, has implemented the following changes for pharmacies to increase the number of available vaccines for UnitedHealthcare Community Plan members .

Manufacturers National Drug Code (NDC)

OptumRx began using the manufacturers’ National Drug Code (NDC) for patients who are UnitedHealthcare Medicaid members using the Vaccine and Immunization/Injection Network. While vaccine coverage eligibility is based on the individual member’s benefit plan, please make sure to bill the correct vaccine NDC from the following list of covered vaccines for 2019-2020.

Administration fee when your pharmacy is administering the vaccine

Pharmacy reimbursement rates for participating UnitedHealthcare Community Plans now include a \$10 administration fee. When a vaccine is administered at the pharmacy, the established retail contract rate fee is additional.

Processing requirements when you supply and administer the vaccine

When your pharmacy provides and administers the vaccine, please populate the National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) field 438-E3 (incentive amount submitted) to submit for the \$10 administration fee and populate field 439-E4 (reason for service code) with “MA”.

Administration fee-only claims

If the vaccine was obtained through a special program such as Vaccines for Children, you may claim the administration fee by submitting the claim as usual, including the administration fee, and changing your usual and customary amount to \$0.01. You will be reimbursed administration fee of \$17.85 + \$0.01.
