

# New Wound Care Program

Starting Nov. 30, 2020

UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Texas is pleased to announce that we have partnered with Vohra Wound Physicians to create a wound care program that complements the care that you provide to your patients with pressure ulcers.

## Who?

Vohra Wound Physicians is the leading national group of wound care physicians that manages patients in the nursing home and community. They serve 27 states and 3,000 facilities. ## What?

This wound care program will serve UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Texas members with stage 3 or 4 pressure wounds.

## How?

Vohra Wound Physicians will manage the outpatient wound care by telemedicine, while you continue to manage any other conditions. They will dispense wound care dressings shipped directly to the member's home and prescribe any wound related medications or antibiotics that may be needed. Vohra will provide you copies of all clinical notes to your office through their Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliant process after each visit. Vohra Wound Physicians will only provide wound care treatment to your patients who are our members, so the overall care and decisions will remain with you and your practice.
