

# Pharmacy prior authorization requirements

Starting March 16, 2021

Starting March 16, 2021, prior authorization will be required for some drugs used to treat excessive daytime sleepiness in adults with narcolepsy, control heavy menstrual bleeding caused by uterine fibroids and treat migraine headaches when prescribed to UnitedHealthcare Community Plan members. The drugs requiring prior authorization are listed in the following chart:
