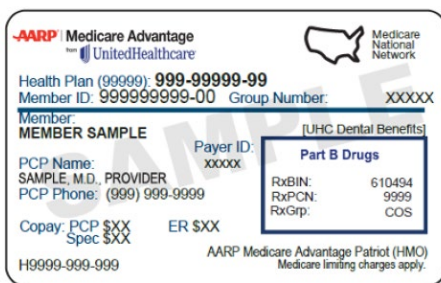


2021 UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage plans with national network

The UnitedHealthcare® Medicare National Network was first introduced Jan. 1, 2020, to eligible local preferred provider organization (LPPO)/regional preferred provider organization (RPPO) plan members. Starting Jan. 1, 2021, some individual Medicare Advantage health maintenance organization (HMO) and point-of-service (HMO-POS) plans are also offering access to the UnitedHealthcare® Medicare National Network. Health care professionals may see members from other states who are enrolled in a UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage plan with the Medicare National Network logo.



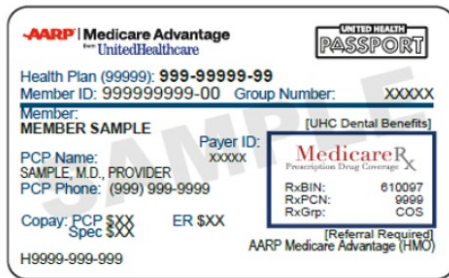
2021 Medicare Advantage sample ID cards



Medicare National Network logo



The Medicare National Network logo replaces the Passport logo on preferred provider organization (PPO) plan ID cards and, new for 2021, some HMO plans are included. **If you see the Medicare National Network logo on the front of the card, these members will not need to activate Passport.** Refer to the sample ID card, as shown above.

The sample ID card above shows a plan with the Passport travel benefit, as indicated by the UnitedHealth Passport logo. **These members are not on a plan that includes the Medicare National Network. These members will be required to activate Passport.**
