Effective July 1, 2026, we've changed format of the field in the table below to match how it appears in the revised Monthly Membership Report from CMS.

- **EC7810 File Layout with Excel Headers** – Identifies and defines code types used for reporting
 - Go to UnitedHealthcare Provider Portal > **Report Center**
 - Select the EC Capitation Report resources dropdown
- **EC7810 file** – Includes data specific to your clinic. The report is securely stored in **UHCprovider.com** and requires a log in for access.
 - From any page on **UHCprovider.com**, select Sign In and enter your One Healthcare ID
 - If you don't have a One Healthcare ID, **register now**
