

Choosing a Quality Skilled Nursing Facility

We believe in helping UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage members receive the resources they need to successfully recover from an acute hospital event and return home. To help you and our members make more informed choices, we've compiled a list of high-performing skilled nursing facilities that may demonstrate improved patient outcomes based on quality and cost efficiency criteria. Skilled nursing facilities offer services to aid in patient recovery, like rehabilitation therapy and care from nurses and specialty care providers.

Quality Assessment

We've created designations based on quality and performance metrics sourced from the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage population and traditional Medicare members from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Nursing Home Compare database. Additional considerations included skilled nursing facilities in active value-based contracts or the presence of an on-site clinician, which resulted in a high-performing provider designation.

We hope this information helps you when assisting members during the discharge planning process. To help answer your questions about the high-performing skilled nursing facilities, we've attached a list of frequently asked questions at the end of this document. Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of the high-performing skilled nursing facility evaluation?

We've identified high-performing skilled nursing facilities to help discharge planners and UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage plan members make more informed health care choices. Physicians may also use these high-performing care providers when referring members who are in need of skilled nursing services. These designations are reviewed on a semi-annual basis.

What are the criteria used to evaluate skilled nursing facilities?

We created designations based on quality and performance metrics of UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage members and traditional Medicare members from the CMS Nursing Home Compare database.

The skilled nursing facility analysis uses a combination of average length of stay, acute readmission rate, presence of a value-based contract and on-site clinical presence, based on the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage membership. In addition, we consider the following metrics from the CMS Nursing Home Compare database:

- Overall CMS star rating
- CMS health inspection rating
- Registered nurse staffing hours
- Overall CMS short term quality rating
- Percentage of re-hospitalizations after a skilled nursing facility admission

Based on analysis of UnitedHealthcare and CMS data, along with local market input, providers were identified as higher-performing and will be suggested for discharge planning recommendations.

Can members select any skilled nursing facility that's part of the UnitedHealthcare network?*

Yes. Regardless of whether a skilled nursing facility is identified as high-performing, members can choose from all participating skilled nursing facilities in the UnitedHealthcare network. Just because a skilled nursing facility isn't on this list doesn't mean that the facility can't provide quality health care services. Members can learn more by checking their benefits plan and asking their health care professionals.
