Dear Empire Plan Network Participant:

We are pleased to provide you with the following updates and reminders in regard to The Empire Plan.

▪ **January 2020 Empire Plan Medical Program Copayment Guide – copy enclosed**

This guide, also previously included in our November 2019 issue of Network News, outlines the copayment requirements for the various Empire Plan employee groups relative to services by participating providers covered under the Empire Plan Medical Program as of January 1, 2020. It also includes columns identifying the appropriate drug list for each group and the outpatient surgical location copayment. **Key changes include a new Urgent Care Center copayment and increased copayment amounts for certain groups. NOTE: APSU, Council 82, PEF, and SEHP continue to have no copayment changes.**

Services not subject to a copayment as a result of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA), also known as federal health care reform, are outlined on the 2020 Empire Plan Preventive Care Coverage Chart, which is enclosed as well.

▪ **Empire Plan Prescription Drug Coverage**

Medicare-Primary Enrollees/Dependents

The Empire Plan Medicare Rx prescription drug plan for Medicare-primary enrollees and dependents is administered by SilverScript Insurance Company, an affiliate of CVS Caremark. Empire Plan enrollees and dependents whose primary coverage is Medicare receive their Empire Plan prescription drug coverage through a Medicare Part D Employer Group Waiver Plan called Empire Plan Medicare Rx. The Empire Plan Medicare Rx (PDP) plan has been designed to provide coverage as close to the non-Medicare Empire Plan Prescription Drug Program as possible and to mirror the Empire Plan Flexible Formulary Drug List as closely as possible.

Enrollees/Dependents Who Are Not Medicare Primary

The Empire Plan Prescription Drug Program, administered by CVS Caremark, provides prescription drug coverage for enrollees and dependents who do not have primary Medicare coverage. There are three drug lists for the Empire Plan Prescription Drug Program: the 2020 Empire Plan Advanced Flexible Formulary Drug List, the 2020 Empire Plan Flexible Formulary Drug List and the 2020 Excelsior Plan Drug List. These are separate and distinct lists that apply to different employee groups with Empire Plan coverage, as noted on the Copayment Guide. Certain drugs are excluded from coverage on the 2020 Empire Plan Advanced Flexible Formulary Drug List and the 2020 Empire Plan Flexible Formulary Drug List.

Copies of the 2020 Advanced Empire Plan Flexible Formulary Drug List and the 2020 Empire Plan Flexible Formulary Drug List are enclosed for your reference. Due to the minimal number of enrollees covered under The Excelsior Plan Drug List, we have not included a copy of that list.

▪ **Empire Plan Claim Submission Deadline for 2019 Services – April 29, 2020**

Empire Plan claims must be submitted to UnitedHealthcare no later than 120 days from the end of the calendar year in which covered services are rendered or within 120 days after Medicare or another insurance plan processes your claim, whichever is later. This means that Empire Plan claims for 2019 services must be submitted to the Kingston Service Center by April 29, 2020.

Electronic claim submission is encouraged. For those unable to submit electronically, paper claims may be submitted to: The Empire Plan, PO Box 1600, Kingston, NY 12402-1600.

If you have not received a response within sixty (60) days following your submission of a claim, promptly contact us to question the status. You may send your inquiry via UHCprovider.com, a Request for Reconsideration Form, or by calling our customer care professionals at 1-877-7-NYSHIP (1-877-769-7447). Contacting us within this timeframe helps to prevent denial of the claim due to late filing if the original was never received.

When benefits are denied because the claim is submitted late, the participating physician or health care professional may not bill the patient for the charges on that claim.

2020 EMPIRE PLAN PREVENTIVE CARE COVERAGE CHART

NYSHIP's Empire Plan includes provisions for expanded coverage of preventive health care services in accordance with the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA). **These charts summarize preventive services covered with no copayment when received from an Empire Plan participating provider.**¹

Children

Yearly preventive care (well-child) visits that include height, weight and body mass index measurements, developmental screenings, behavioral assessments and medical history are covered, as well as the screenings, tests, counseling and vaccines² listed below.

Note: Vaccines administered at a pharmacy are not authorized in New York State for persons under age 18, with the exception of the influenza (flu) vaccine. The influenza vaccine may be administered by pharmacists to persons ages two and older.

Screenings • Tests • Counseling

- Certain newborn screenings including, but not limited to, thyroid disease, phenylketonuria (PKU), sickle cell disease and hearing
- Gonorrhea preventive topical eye medication for newborns
- Developmental/autism screening up to age 3
- Hematocrit or hemoglobin and blood pressure screenings
- Cholesterol and lipid screening for children at higher risk
- Lead exposure screening up to age 7
- Tuberculosis screening
- Visual Acuity Screening for children up through age 21
- Hearing screening
- Application of fluoride varnish in a primary care setting up to age 6
- Obesity screening and counseling for children age 6 and older
- Screening for major depressive disorders
- HIV screening and sexually transmitted infections (STIs) screenings and prevention counseling for adolescents at higher risk
- Cervical dysplasia screening when necessary
- Screening and counseling for interpersonal and domestic violence
- Skin cancer counseling for children beginning at 6 months of age as well as counseling for parents
- Counseling and education by primary care clinicians to prevent initiation of tobacco use in school-age children and adolescents
- Alcohol and drug use assessments
- Screening for hepatitis B virus infection for at-risk individuals

Adults

Yearly preventive care physical and well-woman exams are covered, as well as the screenings, tests, counseling and vaccines² listed below. **Note:** Select vaccines administered at a participating pharmacy are covered.*

Screenings • Tests • Counseling

- Cholesterol and lipid screening for adults age 40-75
- Screening for type 2 diabetes in adults age 40-70 who are overweight or obese or who have high blood pressure
- Colorectal cancer screening, including fecal occult blood test, fecal DNA test, sigmoidoscopy and colonoscopy for adults age 50-75 (This includes pre-procedure consultation and any resulting pathology exam or polyp biopsy for the colonoscopy.)
- Screening for depression
- Screening for gonorrhea, chlamydia, syphilis and HIV
- Counseling for sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
- Screening and counseling for alcohol misuse, tobacco use, obesity, diet and nutrition **in a primary care setting**
- Screening for abdominal aortic aneurysm in men age 65-75 who have ever smoked
- Bone density test to screen for osteoporosis for women age 65 and older or women at risk
- Breast cancer screening mammography every one to two years for women, beginning at age 40
- Counseling and evaluation for genetic testing of women for BRCA breast cancer gene
- Annual lung cancer screening for adults age 55-80 based on risk and smoking history
- Counseling women at high risk of breast cancer for chemoprevention
- Screening women for cervical cancer up to age 65, including Pap test
- Prenatal care and screenings including, but not limited to, bacteriuria, hepatitis B, Rh incompatibility, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia
- Screening for gestational diabetes for women after 24 weeks of gestation
- Human papillomavirus DNA testing every three years for women age 30 and older
- Screening and counseling for interpersonal and domestic violence
- For women, all U.S. Food and Drug Administration-approved contraceptive methods and sterilization procedures and patient education and counseling³
- Breastfeeding support, supplies and counseling, including cost for purchase of breastfeeding equipment in conjunction with each birth
- Skin cancer counseling for young adults up to age 25
- Screening for hepatitis C virus (HCV) infection for at-risk individuals or one-time screening for adults born between 1945 and 1965
- Screening for tuberculosis and hepatitis B virus infection for at-risk individuals

Vaccines • Medications

- Hepatitis A; Hepatitis B; Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR); Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Td/Tdap); Varicella (chickenpox); Human papillomavirus (HPV).
- Can be administered in a physician's office or at a participating pharmacy:
 - Influenza (flu)
 - Pneumococcal (pneumonia)
 - Meningococcal (meningitis)
 - Herpes zoster (shingles)⁴
- Certain prescription and over-the-counter medications that are recommended for preventive services without cost sharing and have in effect a rating of "A" or "B" in the current recommendations of the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF). **Note:** When available over-the-counter, USPSTF "A" and "B" rated medications require a prescription order to process without cost sharing.

* Covered preventive immunizations obtained at a CVS Caremark national vaccine network pharmacy will be paid in full and will not require a copayment, subject to age limitations.

The **Empire Plan Advanced Flexible Formulary** is a guide within select therapeutic categories for enrollees and health care providers. **Generics should be considered the first line of prescribing.** If there is no generic available, there may be more than one brand-name drug to treat a condition. These preferred brand-name drugs are listed to help identify products that are clinically appropriate and cost-effective. This is not an all-inclusive list. This formulary includes a list of commonly prescribed covered drugs by therapeutic class, a Quick Reference Drug List with commonly prescribed covered drugs in alphabetic order, a listing of commonly prescribed non-preferred (Level 3) covered drugs and covered preferred drug alternatives, and a listing of excluded drugs along with covered alternatives. This list represents brand-name drugs in CAPS and generic drugs in lowercase *italics*.

Generally generics are subject to a Level 1 copayment, or the lowest copayment; preferred brand drugs are subject to a Level 2 copayment, and non-preferred brand drugs are subject to a Level 3 copayment, or the highest copayment. Refer to your plan materials for specific information regarding copayment amounts.

ENROLLEE

Your benefit plan provides you with a prescription benefit program administered by CVS Caremark. Ask your doctor to consider prescribing, when medically appropriate, a preferred generic or a preferred brand-name drug from this list. Take this list along when you or a covered family member sees a doctor.

Please note:

- You will be responsible for the full cost of non-formulary products that are excluded from coverage unless a request for a medical exception is approved. New prescription drug products may be subject to exclusion upon release to the market.

- Any brand-name drug for which a generic drug becomes available will be designated as a non-preferred drug. When a generic version is available, mandatory generic substitution will apply. In this case, use of a non-preferred product will result in the member paying the applicable non-preferred copayment plus the difference in cost between the brand-name drug and the generic, not to exceed the full retail cost of the drug (Ancillary Charge).

HEALTH CARE PROVIDER

Your patient is covered under a prescription benefit plan administered by CVS Caremark. As a way to help manage health care costs, authorize generic substitution whenever possible. If you believe a brand-name drug is necessary, consider prescribing a brand-name drug on this list.

- Generics should be considered the first line of prescribing.
- This drug list represents a summary of prescription coverage. It is not all-inclusive and does not guarantee coverage.
- The enrollee's prescription benefit plan may have a different copay for specific products on the list.

If an exception is approved, the Level 1 copay will apply for generic drugs and the Level 3 copay (and ancillary charge, if applicable) will apply for brand-name drugs.

The Flexible Formulary has an additional feature called **Brand for Generic (B4G)** which saves you money on certain Brand-Name drugs that have a new generic available. When advantageous to the Plan, this feature allows a Brand-Name drug to be placed on Level 1, the lowest copayment level, and the new generic equivalent to be placed on Level 3, the highest copayment level or excluded. These placements are for a limited time, typically six months, and may be revised mid-year when such changes are advantageous to The Empire Plan. You will be notified when B4G savings are available. We will also notify your pharmacist so that the lowest cost option will always be dispensed. The Empire Plan has implemented a medical exception process for prescription drugs that are excluded from the Flexible Formulary. Enrollees and their physicians must first evaluate whether covered drugs on the Flexible Formulary are appropriate alternatives. After an appropriate trial of formulary alternatives, an enrollee's physician may submit a letter of medical necessity to CVS Caremark which details the enrollee's formulary alternative trials and any other clinical documentation supporting medical necessity. The physician can fax the exception request to 1-888-487-9257. If an exception is approved, the Level 1 copay will apply for generic drugs and the Level 3 copay (and ancillary charge, if applicable) will apply for brand-name drugs.
