

Essilor Stellest lenses ordering guide

Essilor® Stellest® is an FDA market authorized spectacle lens designed to slow myopia progression in children*¹, and it is now available for UnitedHealthcare | Spectera members.

Step 1: Select lens information and enter charges

In the *Lenses* section, use the drop-down under *Lens Type*, to select Single Vision. Under *Lens Style*, select Single Vision – Free Form. Under *Lens Material* select Polycarbonate (1.59), and under *Lens Treatment* select No Treatment.

Next, enter the retail cost for **Essilor Stellest** in the adjacent *Lens Style* and *Lens Material* currency fields.

Reminder: The lens material is only available in polycarbonate and lens treatments are not available at this time. Your lab will also require an OC height measurement.

Step 2: Select lens options and enter charges

In the *Lens Options* section, choose Anti-Reflective Coating: Tier III. Enter the retail cost in the currency field for *Option 1*. Leave the *Option 2* fields blank.
