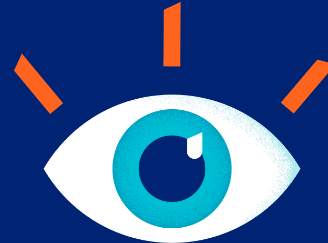

Starting April 1, 2026, UnitedHealthcare Community Vision Network / March Vision Network will no longer manage vision benefits for UnitedHealthcare Community Plan Medicaid members in Louisiana.
