Policy Title	Effective Date	Summary of Changes
Co-Surgeon/Team Surgeon Policy, Professional and Assistant-at-Surgery Services Policy, Professional	February 1, 2023	UnitedHealthcare will align with CMS in the reimbursement for Co- Surgeon (Modifier 62) and Assistant Surgeon (Modifier AS) services. For services included on the Co-Surgeon Eligible List, UnitedHealthcare will reimburse Co-Surgeon services at 62.5% of the allowable amount. Reimbursement for services on the Assistant-at-Surgery Eligible List, which are provided by a Health Care Professional, will be reimbursed at 13.6% of the allowable amount.
Mohs Micrographic Surgery Policy, Professional	November 1, 2022	UnitedHealthcare has revised the Mohs Micrographic Surgery Policy as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> . The multiple procedure reduction will no longer apply when a Mohs surgical procedure and a separate procedure to repair the wound are performed on the same date of service by different provider primary specialties (as identified by UnitedHealthcare) within the same medical group. . Multiple procedure reductions will continue to apply to the same provider performing multiple procedures on the same date of service
